The Division of Research Methods & Social Cognition at Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg (JMU; Institute of Psychology), is seeking to fill a

## **Doctoral Research Position**

to be filled part-time for 75% of the average regular weekly working hours of corresponding full-time employees for a limited period of three years. The contract can start in April 2025 or later. The candidate is encouraged and supported to start and complete their dissertation in the time of the contract. Remuneration is based on the collective agreement for the public service of German federal states (Tarifvertrag für den öffentlichen Dienst der Länder, TV-L 75%).

The applicant will conduct part of the DFG-funded project "ContextualEYEze: The interplay of gaze and context information in person perception, social understanding, and decision-making". For a brief description visit the DFG website: <u>https://gepris-extern.dfg.de/gepris/projekt/550926152</u>

As part of the project, the context-dependent processing of gaze behavior will be investigated in experimental conversation settings. In addition to behavioral studies (including eye-tracking), imaging methods (fMRI) will be used.
