## **Fulltime Post Doctoral Research Associate Position.**

The contract is initially for a fixed term of three years with an intended start date of 1. May 2025. There is a possibility for an extension at the end of the first three year period. The position is full time. Nevertheless, applicants wishing to work part time may be considered. Remuneration will be based on the collective agreement for the public service of German federal states (*Tarifvertrag für den öffentlichen Dienst der Länder*, TV-L).

- Supervise independent student research projects and bachelor/master theses
- Possibility to design and offer an independent course

- Interest in empirical industrial organization and econometric methodology is a plus
- Readiness to be a team player and high-motivation
- Good written and oral English language skills, good German language skills are beneficial
